

CONCEPT NOTE


Blue Economy & Sustainable Restoration: Sustainable global development greatly depends on the strength of our blue economy. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) outline this prominent connection and ways to achieve sustainability by 2030. The United Nations Environment Program estimates that half the world's population lives within 60 kilometers of the sea. They also estimate that three quarters of all large cities are located along the coast. According to the International Maritime Organization, the sea facilitates global trade by: up to 70% by value & up to 90% by volume. Thereby, the concept of the Blue Economy Session serves to complement that of the "Green Economy" by rightly highlighting the environmental challenges facing the world's oceans, which after all account for two thirds of the surface of our blue planet. As crucial providers of food, biodiversity, carbon sequestration, and energy, oceans are true global commons, whose degradation would have disastrous consequences for all of mankind. Of course, coastal countries are most affected & Bangladesh is one those countries, our economics depend most directly on the oceans, be it through fisheries, tourism or exploitation of marine resources. The threats they are facing from overfishing, marine pollution, and climate change are proof that environmental sustainability and economic development are not conflicting goals, but rather necessary complements. Ultimately, all our economies depend on a sustainable stewardship of our natural resources, be they blue or green. The goal of this session is to discuss how to utilize the Blue Economy as a tool to shift development in a country like Bangladesh towards a sustainable development trajectory building on the Rio+20 consensus & there how youths can be a vital part of such developmental glory. Noting that the Blue Economy, founded in line with the concept and principles of, and mutually supportive with the Green Economy, is a tool that offers specific mechanisms for coastal countries to address their sustainable development challenges.

Rights & Youth Advocacy- National Youth Policy: Having identified the potential barriers to the implementation of the National Youth Policy, proposed and recommended solutions that could drive a positive change, BYS 2022 intends to provide an on-going support to the young advocates & policymakers to implement national youth policy. BYS 2022 will raise voice to allocate adequate budget



for youth empowerment and formation of **National Youth Council** as per **Youth Organization registration act 2015** for youth empowerment and youth engagement on policy level.
